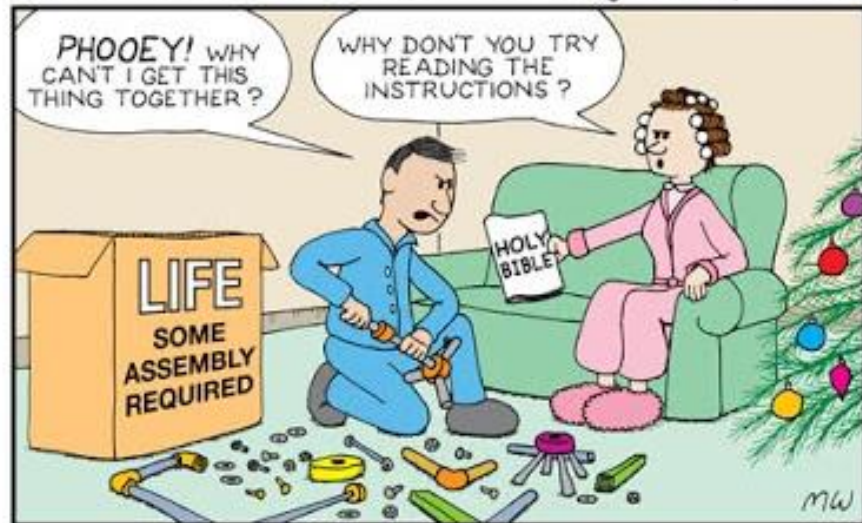


- ANNOUNCEMENTS -
